Business Arising/General Business:

- 1. <u>Creek</u> on Dept of Education land between the Taroona Primary School & Karingal Ave has overgrown vegetation, residents of Southern Cross homes are concerned about the state of the creek. The appearance is unattractive and there are concerns about the health of the creek and it may be a source of snakes. Jill suggests Dept of Education may not have the resources to manage such a difficult problem and perhaps liaising between TCA and Taroona Environment Network (TEN) and residents and school. Jill will raise with TEN and Alison to raise with TPSA.
