- 3. Update on <u>Taroona High School Reserve</u> Jill gave us a brief overview of the way events unfolded, Jill and other local residents wrote to the Minister for Education to request the development of a Master Plan to cover the site, the government encouraged the community to engage directly with the schools to develop this ourselves and submit to them for review. This concept will be promoted through the newsletter to gather community input and use local skills to develop a plan.
