Treasurer's Report - Alison Phillips

On April 26th 2023, the TCA had a balance of \$1086.42 (up from 15/3/23 of \$816.10)

Since my last report of March 15th 2023, we have had \$0.32 interest and 21 new memberships.

We have been invoiced for \$99 for the Community Hosting of the Taroona website,

and \$49 for Basic SSL Certificate. Alison will pay online and be reimbursed via cheque.

We have \$533 left from our Neighbourhood grant to go towards the planned bird bath and seating. This means we effectively have \$405.42.

There are currently 89 financial members.

Insurance for the TCA does not cover the Chiton, other avenues are being investigated through Steadfast brokers. Anne will contact Damian to advise him and not take the Chiton out until resolved.

General Business (incl reviewing actions)

Toilet Block – Dal reported that the toilet block project has been reviewed, council have asked for electricity to be connected for electric hand dryers and lighting. Committee discussed – there was concern that this would result in a cost blowout that would put the project at risk. If it can be afforded the committee was in favour of lighting but electric hand dryers seemed unnecessary and better to keep the project simple. Dal will get back to council.

Louisa Hinsby – Official opening 09.30 am Tuesday May 9th, Fi and Anne will be there and are looking for help on the day. Fiona has approached the Ex-services and TEN for assistance. If anyone can help with a plate of food, it would be appreciated. Fi will send a reminder for the Opening and for the weeding session.

Kingborough Draft Budget – There is little detail able to be viewed, the link from council does not work at time of meeting. \$12,000 for Taroona foreshore track upgrade, \$208,00 for Kelvedon Park drainage upgrade, \$30,000 for Taroona Bowls and Tennis car park, design only, \$250,000 for bike lane improvements, \$30,000 for Hinsby foreshore access, design work only. The committee felt cost of \$30,000 for design work was exorbitant. Bike lane expenditure is high, and com want to know exactly what is proposed, disappointed there is no Master Plan for the Taroona Park and strongly feel this should be funded. Ann and Fi will Speak to Kaspar for further information – Jill and Anne will email us.

Community Battery – forum was held to capture community sentiment and submission was made to TAS Networks but the team has been made redundant and so it is in limbo for the moment, David will organise another meeting

Dog Management Policy – community consultation will occur soon

Newsletter - defer
