Business Arising & General Business:

- Taroona bushfire coordinators narrowed scope of the coordinator role to
 communication and encouragement of preparedness and identifying people who
 need help and people who wish to offer their help. Fi, Anne and Jill have enrolled 44
 volunteers and are currently seeking pre-approval to print names and addresses on
 the flyer to save time for the volunteers, Liz will do this. Printing flyer next week.
 Collation and distribution to volunteers next week also. Taroona Volunteer Fire
 Brigade are currently running neighbourhood drop-in sessions (x3) & these have
 been attended by TCA reps.
- 2. <u>31 Nubeena Cres</u> Jill delivered a letter to local residents to ensure they knew of the development application. Jill alerted council to mistakes and they have had to readvertise the DA.
- 3. <u>Louisa Hinsby Reserve</u> Anne and Warren planted low-maintenance natives that form soft hedges and plan to trim them once a year allowing them to hide the bollards (Kingborough Council approved plan). Update community via the next newsletter *Liz*

- 4. <u>Taroona Park</u> Jill met with the council (Paul Donelly). There is a planting approach to reduce risk to community from limbs falling from the blue gums i.e. planting under the trees to discourage sitting/walking directly under the trees. Paul also notified intention to develop a master plan for the park. Jill showed them Ashtons lookout which needs trimming as the view is obscured.
- 5. <u>TCA Secretary</u> expression of interest from Oberon Carter to take on the secretary role for TCA. This has been accepted and seconded by Anne
- 6. <u>Aust Day award</u> Discussion, Janette to follow up with email
- 7. <u>Illawong Crescent</u> survey of land will be undertaken by council this week. Su Sprott informally mentioned that a connection from the top of the Alum cliffs to Illawong Cres would be very beneficial to the community. Jill to contact property owner
- 8. <u>Sale of council properties</u> 110 Ch Hwy TCA support the proposed sale. Yet to hear the outcome of the council meeting Oct 26. Another property matter Damian advised a property developer is looking to develop bush block above Stewart Ave, wait to see any development application submitted.
- AGM invitation to Anetta Hitchman, Frank Lawrence, June Flood and David Stephens to attend to thank them for their work over the years. AGM NOV 15 All TCA committee members to bring something.
- 10. <u>Tas Networks</u> Fi has a draft grant proposal worked up for Louisa Hinsby and will look to fit it for this opportunity.
- 11. <u>Taroona High School</u> SRC are running a Quiz night fundraiser Thursday 19th (Al will follow up via email to see if we can get enough interest for a table) Fi reported the grounds subcommittee will be re-constituted. There is a broken and blocked stormwater pipe under the lower soccer ground.
- 12. <u>Newsletter</u> recent schedule and demands on committee have been very high, unanimous decision to give Liz a rest and not publish a December newsletter.
