### **Treasurer's Report**

On August 16th, 2023, the TCA had a balance of \$1627.72 (up \$140.55 from 26/7/23 of \$1487.17). Since my last report of June 21st, 2023, we have had \$0.55 interest and 10 new memberships (& a donation of \$40). I sent a cheque for \$200 to PMAT (Planning Matters Alliance Tasmania) as a donation. This has not been banked yet.

We still have \$533 left from our Neighbourhood grant to go towards the planned birdbath and seating. I have again tried contacting the high school to follow up on getting an account from them.

This means we effectively have \$894.72.

There are currently 45 financial members.

## **General Business (incl reviewing actions)**

### Toilet block -

### Insurance -

Skiff is now covered under the insurance offered by SASCRAA membership.

Alison wrote to Georgia, insurance broker, to see if there was any option for insurance covering several community groups but there is not. Allianz are willing to waive stamp duty (approx. \$80) on our insurance. Janette to write to council asking again for them to facilitate an affordable insurance option for community groups in the council area.

Bill Cromer is following it up and will let us know, once we have his report it is for submission from us and TEN to go to council. *Fi* will follow up pedestrian count.
