The Kingborough Council first met on the 6th of January 1908. The following councillors were present at that meeting¹:

H.J. Rule, R. Hart and C.J.C. Lord representing Kingston Ward, which included aroona. C.F. Weston, E.A. Worsley and R. Rollins representing Longley Ward. J.R. Worsley and R. Groombridge representing margate Ward.

P.J. Torpy, Margate Ward was absent.

Mr C.J.C. Lord, retired gentleman, of Taroona House' was elected as the first Treasurer on an annual salary of £10. He was appointed to the subcommittee to draft the initial set of Council bylaws¹.

A fourth ward, Channel Ward, was transferred to Kingborough from the Port Cygnet Municipality in 1911 and a fifth ward, Taroona Ward, created in 1951.

The Council was replaced by a Commission for the period 1960-71 and after the Council was restored the Municipality was divided into three wards:

North Ward, (which includes Taroona)

Central Ward, and

Channel Ward.
